Good response to flush the system. Dex-Cool (Dex-Mud) doesn't mix with other types of antifreeze. Most people elect to get that stuff out and put in regular antifreeze. GM advertised it as "lifetime" coolant to sell more cars but right on the overflow was a sticker that said to replace it every three years.
