10 Simple Rules For Good Writing

Write notes in the margins. Write one-sentence summaries, on a separate sheet of paper for each stage of thought. Write a thesis – a one or two-sentence summary of the entire passage. The thesis should express the central idea of the passage, as you have determined it from the proceeding steps.
