### Adoption of the FGI Guidelines - FGI

The practice standards and guidelines of ASHP, appropri-ate accrediting bodies (e.g., Joint Commission, American Osteopathic Association Healthcare Facilities Accreditation Program, Det Norske Veritas), and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services shall be viewed as applicable, and the hospital should strive to meet all applicable standards.

### ASHP Guidelines: Minimum Standard for Pharmacies in Hospitals

Health Facility Design requires knowledge, skill and experience. These guidelines alone may not be sufficient to ensure good design, however, using these guidelines, a reasonably skilled designer should be able to focus on the required functionality quickly and deliver a product which meets the

minimum Local Health Authority requirements.
